2024 - 2025 IMPACT REPORT

High-Impact Family Engagement Initiatives

Focused on chronic absenteeism through monthly school meetings to review data, proactive family meetings before students became chronically absent, and consistent attendance messaging — leading to a reduction at one school from 12.9% to 4.2%

- Launched EL/ML Family Mentoring, pairing new EL/ML families with peers who speak the same language and have children at the same school level to support smooth transitions.
- Conducted welcoming walkthroughs to foster inclusive, family-friendly school environments.
- Strengthened partnerships with the Farmington Public Library (curriculum-aligned programming) and the Farmington Valley Health District (parent trainings on mental health and technology).
- Supported family-school liaisons with guidance and resources to enhance districtwide engagement efforts.
